The VIE: A Quick Guide

1. What is a VIE?

VIE stands for "Volontariat Internationale en Entreprises". It was created in 2000 as a means to facilitate the transition of young people into the international job market. Under the supervision of the French Embassy and Business France, a VIE engagement can last from 6 to 24 months. There are currently VIE offers in 134 countries offered by 2085 different recruiters!

2. What are the requirements?

There are no profile-based requirements as the VIE spans a great variety of offers in multiple sectors! However, you have to comply with the requirements below to be eligible:

- You are between 18 and 28 years of age.
- You are a French citizen, or a citizen of a EEA country.
- No previous criminal record
